Dear Friend,

The **2016 Fuller Center Bike Adventure (FCBA) Spring Ride** is a 7-day, 400 mile bike ride to raise money and awareness for affordable housing. This year marks the twentieth anniversary of my first ride in 1996 from Louisville, Kentucky, to Atlanta, Georgia! It's going to be great! And I invite you to celebrate with me.

The **Fuller Center for Housing of Greater Kansas City** is the local ministry I helped start in 2009. We are affiliated with **The Fuller Center for Housing**, an international housing ministry founded by Millard and Linda Fuller in 2004. The Fuller Center loves people the way Jesus loves. People who are struggling, hurting, or just need a helping hand are turning to The Fuller Center for assistance.

The Fuller Center for Housing builds new homes and rehabs older homes with low income families to buy at no profit with zero interest mortgages. The Fuller Center also repairs and remodels owner-occupied homes for people who don't have the physical ability or money to do the work. These families make voluntary donations on terms they can afford equal to the cost of the blessing they receive. In this way they bless others in need as they have been blessed. This ministry is happening all over the world. And it's growing fast!

Locally, projects range from wheelchair ramps, grab bars for safety, and minor plumbing repairs to new roofs, bathroom and kitchen remodels for accessibility, and whole house rehabilitation. Relying mostly on gifts from individuals and churches we have built two homes and repaired many more.

Millard Fuller called each home a "sermon of God's love."

This year we are renovating a donated home and have several Greater Blessing Box projects each of which is an opportunity to demonstrate God's love in the world.
